Turmeric Outlook - July 2018

World Scenario

India is the largest producer, consumer and exporter of turmeric in the world. Indian turmeric is considered to be the best in the world market because of its high curcumin content. India accounts for about 80 per cent of world turmeric production and 60 per cent of world exports. Major turmeric exporting countries are India, Thailand, Taiwan, and several other southeast Asian, Central and Latin American countries. The major turmeric importing countries include Japan, Sri Lanka, Iran, UAE, US, UK and Ethiopia.

Indian Scenario

Major turmeric producing states in India are the southern states of Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Karnataka, the eastern states of Orissa and West Bengal and the western state of Maharashtra.

Turmeric crop is mainly sown in India during May-August season. For the year 2018 kharif, it is expected that under normal monsoon conditions, all India turmeric area may go up by 12 - 14% as compared to last year (156,307 hectares) due to higher prices. In Telangana as on 1st August 2018, the area covered under turmeric was 46,692 hectares as against to 41,715 hectares in the corresponding period last year. The same in Andhra Pradesh was reported as 12,320 hectares as compared to 7,998 hectares in the corresponding period last year.

Supply of Turmeric




Fig 1: Supply of Turmeric During 2018-19 Marketing Year (in lakh tonnes)

As per turmeric supply figures given in Fig 1 for 2018-19, the beginning stocks reported around 1.32 lakh tonnes and ending stocks are expected to be around 0.71 lakh tonnes, because of increased domestic consumption and exports due to lower production in current year. Production estimate of turmeric was also down to 4.76 lakh tonnes which is less than last two years.

Turmeric stocks reported lower during current year in the spot market. Currently turmeric stocks in Nizamabad (both old and new crop) were estimated around 5.15 lakh bags (1 bag = 70 kg) as compared to around 7.00 lakh bags in the corresponding period last year. As per trade information, currently, all India Turmeric stocks were reported around 24 - 26 lakh bags (1 bag = 70 kg) as compared to last year 35 - 40 lakh bags.

Turmeric Arrivals

Till now, around 90% of last year (2018-19 marketing year) crop has been traded in all major turmeric markets in India. Except for Duggirala and Salem in the last week of month and Erode in the second week of the month, a continuous decline in arrivals was found in other three major markets of turmeric from first to last week of July 2018.

Domestic Prices of Turmeric

In the month of July 2018, turmeric prices were moved up, while arrivals showed a declining trend. The weekly average prices were above Rs.7300 per quintal in all major markets

of India except in Duggirala market of Andhra Pradesh. This increase in price may be continued during the August month also in the states of Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Maharashtra.

Turmeric Prices and Arrivals in Telangana

As per the latest report of Agriculture Department of Telangana for the year 2018 kharif, the area under turmeric in the state was increased by 4977 hectares to 46,692 hectares as against 41,715 hectares last year. Normal rainfall was reported in four turmeric growing districts at the end of July month.

Currently, turmeric (finger, NCDEX quality) in Nizamabad is trading at Rs.7,500 per quintal. We expect that prices may not fall much further from current levels due to lesser arrivals in all major markets. At these price levels, prospective buyers like stockiests, exporters, masala millers are expected to start accumulating.




Fig 2: Turmeric Modal Prices and Arrivals at Nizamabad Market during January - July 2018

Due to lowered production, the stocks are also declined in the current year as compared to last year leading for rise in spot market prices. Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expect that Turmeric may likely to trade in price range between Rs.7000 - 7500 per quintal during August 2018.
