## **Groundnut Outlook – July 2019**

Groundnut (*Arachishypogaea L*.) is an important oilseed crop in India which occupies first in terms of area and second position in terms of production. China is the largest producer as well as consumer of groundnut in the world with 166.24 lakh tonnes followed by India (68.57 lakh tonnes), Nigeria (30.28 lakh tonnes) and United States (25.78lakh tonnes). According to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Advance Estimates of production of major crops, groundnut production is estimated at 65.02 lakh tonnes for both kharif and rabi 2018-19.

According to the all India kharif crop coverage report, Government of India, as on 5<sup>th</sup>July 2019, groundnut was sown in around 15.58 lakh hectares compared last year (8.70 lakh ha). Among the states, Gujarat stood first in area coverage with 9.91 lakh ha followed by Rajasthan (4.19 lakh hectares), Andhra Pradesh (0.36 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.0.24 lakh ha) and Maharashtra (0.21 lakh ha).

In Telangana, groundnut has been sown in around 1,208 hectares as on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019. Among the districts, Warangal (Rural) stood first in groundnut sown area with 965 hectares followed by Gadwal (127 ha) and Wanaparthy (12 ha).

About 603quintals of groundnut was traded in price range of Rs. 4100 – 5470 per quintal at Gadwal major market during June 2019. The central government has increased the minimum support price of groundnut for the year 2019-20 by Rs. 200 from Rs. 4890toRs. 5090 per quintal.

## **Groundnut Price Outlook**

In Gujarat, 10-15% area under cotton is going to be replaced by groundnut due to delayed monsoon. Moreover the state and central government policies are encouraging farmers to cultivate more area under oilseeds.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that groundnut may trade in a range of **Rs.4400** – **4700** per quintal during the month of July, 2019.
