Soyabean Outlook - July 2019

World scenario

As per USDA, the estimated stocks of soybean in 2018-19 are 27 million tonnes and estimated production of 2019-20 is 113 million tonnes. The trade between US and china is still unresolved, even with the normal exports' sales record; the stocks would still more than 20 million tonnes in 2019-20. Bad weather and heavy rainfall caused more delay in soybean planting and supported CBOT prices to rise so far.

Sovbean prices in India

National Oilseeds Processors Association (NOPA) has reported that 154.79 million bushels soybean was crushed in May 2019, which is lower against 159.99 million bushels in April 2019 and 163.57 million bushels in May 2018.

Soybean oil stocks are reported lower to 1.581 billion pounds in May 2019 as compared to 1.787 billion pounds at the end of April 2019 and also below the 1.856 billion pounds in May 2018.

Telangana scenario

As on 3rd July 2019 area under soyabean during 2019-20 was 74,344 hectares as against 75,612 hectares during 2018-19. Among the districts, Nirmal stood first with 28,876 ha followed by Adilabad (18,005 ha), Kamareddy (15,421 ha), Sangareddy (6,508 ha) and Nizamabad (2,900 ha).

Sovbean Prices in Telangana

Soybean prices increased at various trading centers as supplies are reported down ahead of good demand. Current market situation is not much predictable as soybean prices are volatile. Once farmers start covering kharif area under soybean in a full speed, soybean prices may overcome pressures. However, Government has increased MSP of yellow soybean by Rs. 311 per quintal from Rs. 3399 to Rs. 3710 for 2019-20.
