Maize Outlook - August 2019

Maize or corn (*Zea mays*) is cultivated globally being one of the most important cereal crops worldwide. As per USDA, U.S corn exports reached 45.99 MMT in 2018-19 marketing year. At 0.70 MMT (for the period 19th July - 25th July, 2019) US corn exports were up 22 percent from the previous week and 5 percent from the prior 4-week average. In U.S, Corn has been silked 58% as of 28th July, 2019 which is lower by 35.56% compared to last year and 30.12% from last 5 year average period. It has been dough 13% as of 28th July, 2019. 58% crop of Corn is in good to excellent condition.

In India, kharif maize has been sown in around 69.27 lakh hectares as on 02nd August'19 which is higher than 69.03 lakh hectares covered during corresponding period of last year. Major maize growing states are Madhya Pradesh (15.01 lakh ha), Karnataka (8.89 lakh ha), Rajasthan (8.61 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (7.01 lakh ha), Bihar (3.58 lakh ha), Telangana (3.31 lakh ha) Jammu & Kashmir (1.96 lakh ha), Punjab (1.44 lakh ha) and Andhra Pradesh (0.61 lakh ha). Maize crops are at sowing to vegetative stage. Pests and diseases reported nil till date.

In Telangana, it has been sown in 3.44 lakh hectares as on 07th August'19 which is lower than 4.31 lakh hectares covered during corresponding period of last year. Maize crop is at vegetative stage. Fall army warm is below ETL level in Mahaboobnagar, Gadwal and Khammam districts. In A.P, maize has been sown in around 0.61 lakh hectares as on 31st July'19 which is lower than 0.71 lakh hectares covered during corresponding period of last year.

As per trade information, in Madhya Pradesh, soybean farmers in the Betul- Chhindwara belt have moved to maize this year because of better returns. The Government has increased the MSP of Maize by Rs. 60 per quintal i.e., from Rs. 1700 to Rs. 1760 for 2019-20 kharif season.

Maize modal price at Choppadandi market ranged between Rs. 2112 – 2452 per quintal during July 2019. Maize market prices are ruling above MSP due to increased demand from feed makers and unfavorable weather conditions.

Maize Price Outlook

Corn on CBOT fall by 5.90 USD/MT to 157.28 USD/MT for September'19 contract compared to previous week. However, it could trade firm on the expectation of increase in export demand for U.S corn.

As per trade sources, India exported around 35,016 MT of maize for the month of May'19 at an average FoB of \$288.95/ MT. Indian maize is exported mainly to Nepal through Raxaul followed by Jogbani ICD and Sonauli ICD port. India imported around 15,169 MT of maize for the month of June'19. Out of which, around 13,328 MT was imported from Ukraine for the Kandla port at an average value of \$215.16/ MT.

In Nizamabad, maize is moving towards Hyderabad at Rs.2550--2575 per quintal. In Gulabbagh region of Bihar, maize (Bilty) is trading at Rs.2150 per quintal. Maize is moving towards Haryana at Rs. 2300 per quintal and U.P at Rs. 2200 per quintal.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that maize could trade in a range of Rs. 1950-2150 per quintal during the month of August, 2019.
