
Turmeric Outlook – August 2019

India is the largest producer, consumer and exporter of turmeric in the world. Indian turmeric is considered to be the best in the world market because of its high curcumin content. India accounts for about 80 per cent of world turmeric production and 60 per cent of world exports. Major turmeric exporting countries are India, Thailand, Taiwan, and several other Southeast Asian, Central and Latin American countries. The major turmeric importing countries include Japan, Sri Lanka, Iran, UAE, US, UK and Ethiopia.

As per turmeric supply figures presented in Fig 1 for 2018-19, the beginning stocks reported around 1.32 lakh tonnes and ending stocks are expected to be around 0.71 lakh tonnes, because of increased domestic consumption and exports under lower production condition in marketing year (2018). Production estimate of turmeric in 2018 was also down to 4.76 lakh tonnes which is less than last two years.

Major turmeric producing states in India are the southern states of Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Karnataka, the eastern states of Orissa and West Bengal, and the western state of Maharashtra.

In the current year, Turmeric sowing in Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Tamil Nadu has delayed by 10-15 days due to delayed monsoon. It was almost completed in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana by till date. So far around 65-70% of turmeric area was only covered in Maharashtra due to lower rainfall. In Tamil Nadu also, only 40-45% of Turmeric area was covered due to lower rainfall. Normally turmeric sowing may continue till August and so area may extend. We expect Turmeric prices to trade range bound to firm in coming days.

In Andhra Pradesh, Duggirala market new turmeric crop supply continued in the market. Currently on an average 10,000-11,000 quintals are reported on daily basis. In Erode mandi new turmeric supply reported around 3,000-3,112 quintals on an average daily basis. In Warangal market, new turmeric supply continued to the market at an average daily basis of 2,329 quintals. In Nizamabad, current season new turmeric arrivals reported around 92,540 MT till 26^{th} July compared to last year same period 72,688 MT i.e.,27.31% more reported as compared to last year.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expect that Turmeric is likely to trade in price range between **Rs.** 6600 – 6800 per quintal during August 2019.
