Maize Outlook – December 2019

Maize or corn (*Zea mays*) is cultivated globally being one of the most important cereal crops worldwide. As per USDA, U.S corn exports reached 5.21 MMT in the 2019-20 marketing year. At 0.67 MMT (for the period 08th November - 14th November, 2019) US corn exports were up by 12% from the previous week mainly for the destinations like Mexico (375,000 MT), Colombia (134,900 MT), Japan (71,400 MT), Costa Rica (32,800 MT), and Panama (22,900 MT). In U.S, 76% of Corn was harvested as of 17th November, 2019 which is lower by 13% compared to last year.

In India, rabi maize has been sown in around 6.30 lakh hectares as on 28th November 2019 which is lower than 7.15 lakh hectares covered during corresponding period of last year. Major maize growing states are Tamilanadu (1.22 lakh ha), Bihar (1.87 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.410 lakh ha), Maharastra (0.459 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.501 lakh ha), Telangana (0.260 lakh ha) and Andhra Pradesh (0.180 lakh ha).

In Telangana, it has been sown in 35476 hectares as on 04th December 2019 which is lower than 68531 hectares covered during corresponding period of last year. In Andhra Pradesh, maize has been sown in around 0.180 lakh hectares as of 28th November 2019 which is lower than 0.560 lakh hectares covered during corresponding period of last year.

As per trade sources, India exported around 11,343 MT of maize for the month of September'19 at an average FoB of \$326.99/ MT. Out of which, around 8,040 MT of Indian maize was exported mainly to Nepal through Jogbani ICD followed by Sonauli ICD and Bhimnagar port. India imported around 36,982 MT of maize for the month of October'19. Out of which, around 27,200 MT was imported from Ukraine for the Kandla port at an average value of \$197.50 USD/MT. Meanwhile, around 9,782 MT was imported from Myanmar for the Chennai and Tuticorin port at an average value of \$263.18/ MT.

Maize modal price at Kesamudram market ranged between Rs. 1681 - 1889 per quintal during November 2019. Maize market prices are ruling above MSP due to increased demand from feed makers.

Maize Price Outlook

Corn on CBOT fall by 2.86 USD/MT to 145.07 USD/MT for December'19 contract compared to previous week. However, it could trade firm on the expectation of increase in demand for U.S corn. At 0.67 MMT US corn exports were up by 12 percent from the previous week and 41 percent from the prior 4-week average.

In Devangere area of Karnataka, due to cloudy weather, maize arrivals are still containing moisture up to 30%. Also size of grain is medium; being traded in a range of Rs. 1450-1700 per quintal. In Nizamabad, maize is trading weak due to arrival pressure. However, feed makers demand could support the market at lower level. Due to recent rains, maize arrivals are containing moisture up to 18%, fungus 5% and damaged grains around 10-15%. Maize is moving towards Hyderabad at Rs. 2150-2200 per quintal while, it is being bought by local starch feed makers at Rs. 1800 per quintal. Maize which contains 6% fungus and 2% maize dust, being loaded for Vijayawada region of Andhra Pradesh at Rs. 1850-1870 per quintal.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that maize could trade in a range of Rs. 1600-1850 per quintal during the month of December, 2019.
