
Castor Outlook – September 2019

Castor is mostly grown in arid and semi-arid regions. It is cultivated in 30 different countries on commercial scale of which India, China, Brazil, Russia, Thailand, Ethiopia and Philippines are major castor seed growing countries accounting for nearly 88% of the world's production.

All India kharif oilseeds sown area was reported as 173.34 lakh ha on 6th September 2019 as against 173.55 lakh ha in the corresponding period of last year. Castor area was reported as 7.63 lakh ha as against 6.46 lakh ha during the same period of last year. In India, major castor producing states are Gujarat (5.77 lakh ha), Rajasthan (1.14 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.30 lakh ha), Telangana (0.22 lakh ha) and Odisha (0.04 lakh ha). In Telangana major growing districts are Narayanpet (6973 ha), Wanaparthy (5242 ha), Mahabubnagar (5104 ha) and Gadwal (2162 ha). According to Government 4th advance estimate, castor production in 2018-19 is at 12.15 lakh tonnes.

All India castor seed price traded firm by 1.32% from last week and currently moving in the range of Rs. 4950-4960 / quintal, also up by 22.5% from last year price of Rs.4048 / quintal. Castor seed price is likely to trade up in coming weeks due to lower production According to the trade sources, all India castor sowing acreage this year might increase as compared to last year due to higher price of castor in domestic markets during last year.
