Turmeric Outlook – February 2020

India is the largest producer, consumer and exporter of turmeric in the world. Indian turmeric is considered to be the best in the world market because of its high curcumin content. India accounts for about 80 per cent of world turmeric production and 60 per cent of world exports. Major turmeric exporting countries are India, Thailand, Taiwan, and several other Southeast Asian, Central and Latin American countries. The major turmeric importing countries include Japan, Sri Lanka, Iran, UAE, US, UK and Ethiopia.

Major turmeric producing states in India are the southern states of Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Karnataka, the eastern states of Orissa and West Bengal, and the western state of Maharashtra.

As per Andhra Pradesh Government, area under turmeric reported as on 15th October 2019 was 13,223 hectares as compared to 20,359 hectares in the corresponding period of last year. The same in Telangana state as on 25th September 2019 was reported as 48,119 hectares.

New Turmeric supply is entering Nizamabad spot market with higher moisture level around 13 - 15%. New Turmeric supply to Duggirala spot market is likely to start from third or fourth week of February. In Nizamabad indicative market during current year (2020), Turmeric arrivals reported around 3,668 MT from 2nd January till 31st January compared to last year same period (2,198 MT), i.e., 66.88% reported up from last year. In Andhra Pradesh, turmeric supply is being continued to Duggirala market on an average daily basis 4,900 quintal during last week as compared to 6,500 quintals in previous week. In Erode mandi, Turmeric supply reported around on an average daily basis 3,000 quintals last week, as against 2,350 quintals in previous week.
