Paddy Outlook - January 2020

Paddy is cultivated globally being one of the most important cereal crops worldwide. USDA in its November report had estimated the global availability of rice at 67.10 million tons in 2019-20 marketing season. The same has been increased by 6 lakh tons to 67.16 million tons in the December report. The main reason for this is the increase in China's production. USDA has increased China's rice production estimates by 7 lakh tons to 14.77 million tons, based on the latest data from the National Bureau of Statistics of China.

As per the ministry of Agriculture, rabi rice acreage as on 03rd January 2020 has increased by 15.59% to 16.16 lakh hectares as compared to 13.98 lakh hectares during the same period of last year. Higher acreage was covered in Tamil Nadu (9.74 lakh ha) and Andhra Pradesh (3.38 lakh ha), whereas, lower acreage was reported from major states such as Karnataka (0.05 lakh ha) and Telangana (1.29 lakh ha).

In Telangana, it has been sown in 1.27 lakh hectares as on 03rd January 2020 which is lower than 0.77 lakh hectares covered during corresponding period of last year. Major paddy growing districts in Telangana are Nalgonda (8010 ha), Medak (10750 ha), Jagtiyal (2168 ha), Kamareddy (810 ha), Yadadri (2540 ha) and Sangareddy (752 ha).

Modal prices of Paddy-Grade-A (RNR) at Kesamudram market and Paddy-Common at Suryapet market ranged between Rs. 1830-1941 and Rs. 1489-1639 per quintal during December 2019 respectively. The Government has increased MSP of normal grade paddy by 65 rupees to Rs. 1815 and 'A' grade paddy to Rs. 1835 per quintal.

Paddy Price Outlook

Indian rice export prices have rise as demand picks up and paddy prices on the local market rose. As per government data, Indian rice exports in October'19 fell by 42% year-on-year to 485,898 tons due to weak demand from African countries for non-basmati rice.

Telangana state government had spent Rs. 4,200 crores towards procuring paddy commodity during kharif season from about 4.16 lakh farmers by opening 3,500 procurement centers this year. And procured 23 lakh tons of paddy, of which 22 lakh tons was sent to mills for processing. In this procurement, Nizamabad district has topped with about 4 lakh tons.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that Paddy-Grade-A (RNR) and Paddy-Common could trade in price ranges of Rs. 1850-2000 per quintal and Rs. 1450-1550 per quintal respectively during the month of January, 2020.
