Groundnut Outlook – July 2022

Groundnut is an important oilseed crop in India which occupies first position in terms of area and second position in terms of production after soyabean. China ranks first in groundnut production with 17.57 million tonnes followed by India 6.73 million tonnes, Nigeria 4.45 lakh tonnes, Sudan 2.83 million tonnes and United States of America 2.49 million tonnes accounting for 36.01, 13.79, 9.12, 5.80 and 5.11 percent of total world production of 48.80 million tonnes in 2019-20. According to the 3rd advance estimates, groundnut production estimate (kharif and rabi) was 10.08 million tonnes for 2021-22 as against 10.24 million tonnes in 2020-21.

According to the all India kharif crop coverage report, Government of India, as on 8th July 2022, groundnut was sown in around 20.52 lakh hectares as compared to last year (25.31 lakh ha). Among the states, Gujarat stood first in area coverage with 10.15 lakh ha followed by Rajasthan (5.85 lakh ha), Karnataka (1.14 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (0.81 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.74 lakh ha) and Telangana (0.01 lakh ha).

In Telangana, groundnut has been sown in around 2,960 acres as on 6th July 2022. Among the districts, Warangal stood first in groundnut sown area with 1,412 acres followed by Gadwal (780 acres), Suryapet (464 acres), Nagarkurnool (176 acres) and Wanaparthy (61 acres). According to the 2nd advance estimates, Telangana groundnut production estimate was 3.42 lakh tonnes (kharif 0.24 lakh tonnes and rabi 3.18 lakh tonnes) for 2021-22 as against 2.90 lakh tonnes (kharif 0.24 lakh tonnes and rabi 2.66 lakh tonnes) in 2020-21.

Groundnut Price Outlook

In Oct '21-April '22, India's Groundnut export went down by 24% to 3.72 lakh tonnes as compared to 4.89 lakh tonnes in the same period last year. Low demand from China contributed to the lower exports, while there is good demand from South East Asian countries like Indonesia, Malaysia and Philippines.

During the above same period, India's Groundnut oil export also went down by 95% to 9,701 tonnes as compared to 2.11 lakh tonnes in the previous same period. Here too, the lower exports can be attributed to low demand from China. Last year China imported groundnut oil heavily from India on account of local crop damage.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that groundnut may trade in a range of **Rs. 5400** – **5800** per quintal during the month of July 2022.
